- KNOW YOUR MEETING ALTERNATIVES Chat and email, Async (Loom, Circle, Voodle), Audio-only tools (Clubhouse, conference calls, Yak)

ERGONOMICS CHECKLIST

- DISABLE SELF-VIEW Hover over your video and select "..."
- POSITION YOUR WINDOWS Put it near the camera for "eye contact"
- ADD NON-VIDEO INTERACTIONS Polls, audio-only breaks, breakout rooms
- VARY YOUR VIEWS Gallery to speaker, screen share resize

- CREATE AN AGENDA (AND STICK TO IT)

 Value your audience's time
- MODERATE THE CONVERSATION

 Stay on topic, don't let anyone dominate

- EASE SOCIAL UNCERTAINTY

 Explain when & how to interact
- COMMUNICATE RULES & EXPECTATIONS

 Self view off? Videos on? Audio
 unmuted? Questions now or held until
 the end? How to speak up?

- SCHEDULE Q&A SESSIONS
 Short, direct, at regular intervals
- CONDUCT LIVE POLLS / SURVEYS
 Foster a feeling of involvement
- HAVE MULTIPLE SPEAKERS
 invite team members to lead sections
- ENCOURAGE PARTICIPATION

 There's nothing more exciting than talking about yourself. Build in ways to let people share.

SERENDIPITY CHECKLIST

- TRY DIFFERENT PLATFORMS

 There are great Zoom alternatives
 (Remo, whereby, icebreaker.video eg.)
- CALL ON PEOPLE AT RANDOM

 Keep them on their toes (and awake)
- ADD A JOKE OR GIF
 Get them laughing (add puppies?)
- USE SOUNDS OR EMOTES
 Use emoji in the chat or a soundboard
- LET YOUR AUDIENCE CONTRIBUTE

 People are engaged when they're sharing
- TRY SLIDES WITH FRIENDS

 Call on people with a "Pass the mic" slide, embed gifs, play hilarious sounds, run live polls, play a "Photo share" slide, it has every one of these tips built in so you don't have to do any work. We built it specifically to help beat zoom fatigue, after all.
